Garage Rentals: For those riders or teams who would like a garage for the ASRA/CCS event, the fees are \$300 for the roll-down units, (no interior walls), and \$150 for the open-air spaces. For those riders or teams who would like a garage for the AMA Pro event, the fees are \$600 for the roll-down units, (no interior walls), and \$300 for the open-air spaces (This fee includes the entire Bike Week 2009). Riders who have rented garages will be entitled to that unit and are welcome to put as many people as will fit into their space without causing a problem with your neighbors in the garages next to you. If there is a problem, we will remove all but the rider that originally rented the unit and his machines.

AMA Pro entrants will be assigned garages in the Yellow Area until the units are all rented. After those units are filled, AMA Pro over-flow will be assigned units in the Blue garages.

ASRA/CCS entrants will be assigned space in the Blues garages. Blue garages will be locked down 60 minutes after ASRA/CCS events end for the day. Renters for the ASRA/CCS event only must move their equipment out of the Blue garages Sunday evening March 1st 60 minutes after the last checkered flag so AHRMA can move in.
