## ASRA Team Challenge Opener at Homestead Miami Speedway on February 9

The American Sportbike Racing Association would like to announce that the first round of the Team Challenge Championship will be at Homestead Miami Speedway for 2019. The AMA Sanctioned ASRA Team Challenge Series will have a 8 race national championship giving all ASRA/CCS licensed riders an opportunity to try racing under a different format from the traditional CCS Sportsman events.

The ASRA Team Challenge Series will still have four classes, GTL, GTU, GTO and Overall. ASRA will continue to support each

class with cash contingency as well as support from a myriad of returning contingency sponsors for each class.

The 2019 ASRA Series will kick off at Homestead Miami Speedway on February 9 with the ASRA Team Challenge on Sunday and the CCS Series Sprints on Saturday and Sunday.

So join us at Homestead Miami Speedway in Homestead FL for a great way to kick off the 2019 ASRA Team Challenge Series and the Championship Cup Series Florida Sprints on February 10. You'll be glad you did!

## ASRA Series Sanctions 2019 Daytona 200

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. – America's most historic motorcycle race, the DAYTONA 200, will continue a tradition of racing on the high banks in 2019 with its 78th running on Saturday, March 16, 2019, at Daytona International Speedway

The 57-lap, 200-mile race on the 3.51-mile road course will showcase 600cc sportbikes sanctioned by the American SportBike Racing Association (ASRA) for the fourth straight year. We are looking forward to celebrating this event's rich history with an exciting event featuring riders battling for a \$175,000 purse and a Rolex Cosmograph Daytona awarded to the winner of the race.

In 2019, Danny Eslick became only the 3rd man to win the Daytona 200 four times trailing only Scott Russell (1992, '94-95, '97-98) and Miguel DuHamel (1991, '96, '99, 2003, '05) who have won the classic five times. Eslick accomplished the feat by staying near the top of the leader board until the final pit stop then working his way clear of second place by a whopping 26.294 second margin of victory over Cory West in second place. The battle for third went to Robertino Pietri who made a last lap pass to come home a scant 0.173 seconds ahead of fourth place Geoff May .

In addition to the Daytona 200, ASRA and the Championship Cup Series (CCS) will have a full complement of road races Friday, March 15 through Sunday, March 17. Daytona 200 qualifying will take place on Friday, March 15 with the race going green the following day at 1 p.m.

The 78th running of the Daytona 200 will be a milestone event for motorcycle road racing in America and ASRA is excited to serve as the sanc-

tioning body for the event. The sheer magnitude of what the Daytona 200 means to American motorcycle road racing cannot be understated. With its history, this unique event has continually turned good racers into stars and then stars into superstars as they fought to win this prestigious race.

In addition to the full road racing calendar and the Daytona International Speedway will continue to be the driving force behind Bike Week hosting a wide range of activities. On Saturday night, March 10, Daytona International Speedway will host the only Monster Energy AMA Supercross event in Florida – the prestigious Daytona Supercross By Honda.

Then the American Flat Track TT event on March 14 inside the speedway. The course will be set up right behind the finish line on the front straight of the famed speedway allowing a better view for spectators from the Tri-oval Grandstands.

The AFT TT event replaces the road race on track activity Thursday but move in and set-up will begin at 8:00am March 14th.

Once again Daytona 200 entrants who pre-enter will receive one complementary space in the Rider/Owner lot to park their RV for the entire event. Pre-entry and garage rental forms are available at [www.ASRARacing.com](http://www.ASRARacing.com).

## Reminder on Transponder Program for 2019

We would like to remind you that it is your responsibility to activate your transponder before entering the track for practice or races.

If your transponder fails to activate, you are to pull off to the side and notify officials immediately for reactivation or temporary replacement. If you fail to do this, you may not be scored, and nobody wants that to happen.

So please go slow and check for the activation light (multiple flashes) on the top of your unit while going through activation

area. And if there is a problem, ask for help immediately so we can insure you have the very best racing experience with us.

For those of you who want to skip the activation step, we have 12 volt hard wired Westhold transponders and rechargeable transponders available for a discounted price of \$180, a \$30 savings from suggested retail.

For those in the Team Challenge, you will still be required to rent or own a MyLaps transponder for 2019 events.

## ASRA Contingency

The greatest feature of this ASRA contingency is how easy it is to qualify for the reward. Simply fill out your contingency form and have the technical inspector verify you have the correct AMA and ASRA Series stickers displayed on both sides of the machine used in the eligible class. That's it, that's all you have to do.

### ASRA Contingency Requirements:

All machines must display an approved AMA and ASRA Series sticker on both sides of the machine. A completed ASRA contingency form must be presented, with each motorcycle, at tech inspection for official verification. All forms must be presented and signed at tech inspection with the motorcycle before racing starts. To officially be considered a finisher, you must meet the requirements found in 3.4.7 with regard to placement on the results.

**ASRA Contingency Restrictions:** ASRA Contingency rewards are scheduled to be processed and mailed out within 45 days of the event, so if you have not received your award by 60 days after the event, contact the ASRA/CCS office at 817-246-1127 or email Eric Kelcher at contingency@ccsracing.us. Inquiries made later than 75 days past the event will not be accepted.

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## 2019 ASRA/CCS PRE-ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

**Please print all information- clearly, carefully, and legibly.**  
**If we cannot decipher your information with some degree of confidence, we will return the entry for clarification.**

- 1. Rider Information Section:** Fill in your Member # if known, your 2019 Competition #, and check either Amateur or Expert. Print your personal information. Give us the emergency contact information we need. Please make certain to include your Westhold Transponder number if available.
- 2. Class Section:** To enter a class, print the brand and model of motorcycle (Yamaha R-1, Kawasaki ZX10, Suzuki GSXR, Etc.) in the BRAND/MODEL column next to each class that you are entering, and then print the displacement in the CC column. To enter the Rookies Cup Challenge check the box beside your class. For Vintage please type in the class or classes in the Brand/Model section and then the brand and size of your machine in the appropriate sections. If you are entering multiple Vintage classes on the same bike, type-in all the appropriate classes. For multiple bikes, use an additional form and mark it "add-on". **If you are entering CCS or ASRA classes on an ASRA weekend you must enter your AMA membership number on the entry form.**
- 3. Race 1 or Race 2 Selection:** These boxes are only used for CCS Twin Sprint entries. As of December 1, 2018, these events are: Carolina Motorsports Park, Summit Point in June, Blackhawk Farms in July, Roebbling Road in August and the September event at NJMP. If you do not check these boxes, we will automatically enter you in Race 1 only.
- 4. Fees:** Pre-Entry fees are \$85.00 for the first CCS class entered and \$65.00 for each additional CCS class entered. All events at NJMP are \$95 for the first pre-entry and includes electricity and camping. All ASRA classes are \$95.00 pre-entry.
- Practice pre-entry** is \$150 for those events with an ASRA/CCS hosted practice before the event and counts as a first entry for the event. (These events are: Autobahn in April, Summit Point in May, Blackhawk Farms in May and August.)
- Daytona Bike Week** pre-entry prices are \$130, each additional class is \$95. As in the past, the first CCS pre-entry includes your Hot Pit Credential, a \$65 value. For those who choose to post enter the event, it will be \$100 per class plus you will have to purchase a credential.

Checks on US banks should be for the full amount calculated as above. Canadian or other international riders must remit by either charge card, cashiers check or money order in US funds. All checks or money orders should be payable to CCS or ASRA.

**Master Card/Visa/Discover:** Please fill in the blanks on the front of the form. Check off the correct card type (Master Card, Visa, or Discover). We must have the **billing zip code, expiration date, CVN number, complete card number and name** as printed on the card. Declined charges will result in a return of the entry form without processing to the rider. Declined charges void original delivery date; entry will be processed as of the date payment is made on resubmitted pre-entries. 

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## Rules Committee Recommendations for 2019 Season

The 2018 Rules Committee has met and considered proposals for rule and procedure changes to the 2019 ASRA/CCS Rulebook. Below are the recommendations that have been added to 2019 Rulebook:

### ASRA Updates:

#### SportBike

**6.7.2.B. Brake rotors may be replaced but must be the same dimensions as the original model or smaller and must be made of a ferrous material. Non-current motorcycles may use brake rotors up to the same size as those that come as original equipment on the current model machine.**

6.7.5 Displacement limits are absolute and are set as follows:

**Three cylinder, liquid cooled, up to 770cc**

**6.7.2.H. Tire choice is open to the competitor. DOT approved, racing slicks or commercially available wet weather tires are permitted. Competitors are responsible for evaluating the individual product and assess the suitability for the event.**

**6.10.Moto 3 (Amateur & Expert Divisions)**

### CCS Updates:

#### **All Middleweight Classes:**

**Three cylinder, liquid cooled, up to 770cc**

**6.2.1.B. Brake rotors may be replaced but must be the same dimensions as the original model or smaller and must be made of a ferrous material. Non-current motorcycles may use brake rotors up to the same size as those that come as original equipment on the current model machine.**
