2007 Rules Committee Decisions

There was no shortage of suggestions for the 2007 Rules Committee to consider and they have successfully pared all input down to a few concise changes for the new season.

First, they have voted to add Superstock to the ASRA Pro Series for 2007. While earlier it appeared they would drop Superbike, pending negotiations for a class sponsor have kept the class alive for now.

Regarding Honda F2's in Lightweight classes, the committee's decision was against that proposal. Right now only Thunderbike has a provision for the machines age to be a factor and the committee felt it was best to hold to that standard.

After meeting several times between October 1 and November 1st, the 2007 Rules Committee has rendered its 'findings' for the new season. Points of interest for CCS racing are as follows:

Ultralight Superbike will run as a combined class, with Expert and Amateurs competing against one another for points and contingency during the season.

Lightweight SuperSport displacements

have been adjusted to read:

Twin cylinder, Air cooled, 2 Valve up to 1210cc

Twin cylinder, Air cooled, 4 Valve up to 1100cc

Buell XBRR is excluded from CCS Thunderbike competition.

Clarification of alternate ECU mounting in Section 5.4.2 to read "as close to perpendicular to the rear axle as possible. in all cases it is illegal to mount the ECU forward of the rider on the machine.

Change to Section 5.2.16....All machines must remove enough bodywork to see the oil fill, oil filter and oil drains before coming to Tech Inspection so the inspectors can verify compliance.

After comparing entry numbers of the current **CCS F40** class with those of other organizations that allow 1000cc fours to compete, the Rules Committee once again voted to stay with the current 750cc SuperSport limitations. Citing the 25 to 30% decline in entries shown when you change the limits, the committee felt it would not be in the best interest of the sport to change the class at this time.

After watching the **practice schedule**

used at the CCS/ASRA combined events, the 2007 Rules Committee has proposed that we use the same type schedule at our regular CCS events. In their opinion, not only would this ease the confusion by standardizing all the practice groups, but it would allow more flexibility for the Race Director to combine practice groups at those events with lower turnouts without compromising the amount of practice available to those riders with multiple machines. They also recommended we discontinue Expert Speedscreen Unlimited GP qualifying to free up more time for the added practice groups, reasoning the time was better spent on all riders than the 5-10% who run the class.

Other changes are just clarifications in the refund procedure, purse payout, gridding after a red flag and addition of the RAL color chart numbers for acceptable shades of yellow on number plates so check out the full posting of the 2007 Rules and Regulations on www.CCSPacing.us.

Bikeweek 2007 Will Run on "AMA" Road Course at Daytona

In keeping with the new "tradition" started during the 23rd Race of Champions, saving the traditional road course for Biketoberfest, we will return to the "AMA" course for the spring event.

This means that during the Thursday Team Hammer practice, move-in will only take place during breaks in the on-track action after 10:00am.

(Simply because we have to cross the actual racing surface to enter the paddock and infield with our trailers and transporters.) While we have plenty of practice at this, invariably someone's patience runs out and they cause delays for everyone, so we ask that you stay with your vehicle if you want to move in on Thursday March 1.

We are looking forward to another successful event run in conjunction with the MOTO-ST series opener, so look inside at the projected schedule and start making your plans now to attend.

2007 License Renewal Deadline January 2, 2007

In order to keep your 2006 number you must renew your license by January 2nd, 2007. If you have not renewed your license by then, you will be in danger of losing your number, since all unclaimed numbers are available on a first come, first served basis as of January 3rd.

Enclosed in this mailer are blank license forms. Also you will notice on the back of your license application is a form for sponsor listings for 2007. Please fill this out if you know who your 2007 sponsors will be. This will help us have your sponsors correct for your first race of the season, so please help us help you!

A reminder to all Amateurs who scored more than 400 points last season, won a Regional Championship, won a Track Championship or finished in the top 5 during the Race of Champions: You have been automatically upgraded to Expert for the 2007 season. (Those who have made the grade are listed alphabetically on our website as well as on page 2.) If you feel this is an error, you have the right to request a down-grade to Amateur

status, but this must be in writing with your reasons for reclassification clearly stated. As per the rules, every rider has the right to request a down-grade once during a career, unless an extended period of inactivity precedes the request. The act of making the request does not guarantee a down-grade, it just insures you will be given the opportunity to plead your case.

For those of you who earned a Top-Ten number in your region, please contact Eric Kelcher in the Fort Worth office before sending in your renewals, there are some special rules regarding your number assignments.

Remember, 2007 fee for ASRA License is \$165.00 (Which includes your CCS license) and CCS License fee is \$115.00 for the calendar year.
