

V.I.R. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please make every effort to comply with the following rules and regulations set forth by V.I.R. Doing so will make it possible for us to continue racing at this wonderful facility in the future.

Speed Limits are strictly enforced: Paddock: 15 mph; Access Roads: 25 mph

Motorized pit bikes, golf carts, ATVs are permitted as long as the operator has a valid drivers license. During Hot Track hours, children (under age 16) are prohibited from driving any motorized vehicle as well as riding bicycles, roller blades, skateboards and scooters in the paddock. Children are permitted to ride unmotorized vehicles at the conclusion of the racing day as long as they do so safely and with consideration for others.

Pets must be leashed. VIR discourages bringing pets to the track. Pets will be allowed if they are leashed and if you clean up after them. If we see pets unleashed, we will find the owner and both will be asked to leave. Do NOT take leashed pets onto false grid or pit areas. Pets are not allowed in any of VIR's buildings or concession areas.

Quiet Time: Unmuffled engines must not be run between 8:00pm and 8:00am Friday and Saturday; Sunday between 11:00am and 12:00 noon. Do not play loud music or bass-boomers in camping areas and paddock; be considerate of neighbors.

Fire Extinguishers: Each participant must have at least 1 portable Dry Chemical fire extinguisher with a rating of at least 12 BC available and in good working condition in their pit area.

Protect the asphalt: Stakes or holes of any kind in any asphalt surfaces are not permitted. Offenders will be held liable for all damages and may also be ejected from the VIR premises. Jacks are permitted but MUST have metal or wood under the jack and jack stands to prevent indentations or holes in the asphalt.

Do not fuel your motorcycle or any other vehicle on any paved areas, except only as permitted on pit road during racing competition. Any fuel spills shall be immediately cleaned up and also diluted with at least 1 gallon of water.

To keep a Fire Lane open to traffic at all times, Pop-ups and Campers must be completely off of the paddock pavement.

Disposal of Waste Fluid and Environmental Debris: Use of the drums located in several areas in the paddock is mandatory for used oil, antifreeze, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Spillage will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the facility. Participants are to take with them all used tires, batteries and unwanted parts. Environmental debris left behind may result in fines or fees.

Alcoholic Beverages: Drinking alcohol of any kind is prohibited in the paddock, pits and VIR buildings during Hot Track hours. Anyone breaking this rule will be removed from the premises immediately and may be fined. After Hot Track hours, please use plastic containers. Please do not bring glass containers or hard liquor to VIR.

No campfires/ground fires; no fireworks or weapons are permitted.

No standing on pit wall; no climbing over fences. Fence jumpers will be ejected from the property. Do not enter areas behind fences without permission from emergency personnel.

No smoking is permitted in any of the VIR buildings. Please extinguish in the receptacles provided.

All competitors and spectators are required to vacate the track by 7:00pm Sunday.
