

## BARBER MOTORSPORTS PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

**Paddock Announcements:** If you cannot hear the PA announcements, **Tune your radio to 106.3 FM.**

**Camping:** If you have paid the camping fees, Motorhomes and Campers are allowed in the paddock overnight. Tents must be erected only in the designated camping area. No tents are allowed in the paddock.

**Electricity:** Limited power is available at this time on a 1<sup>st</sup> come/1<sup>st</sup> serve basis in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> levels. Barber staff will collect fees from you in the paddock if you plug in.

**Speed Limits are strictly enforced.** Obey posted speed limits at all times. Where not posted otherwise, speed limit is 15mph throughout BMP.

**Motorized pit bikes, golf carts, ATCs ATVs are permitted as long as the operator carries a valid drivers license.** No skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, razor scooters, or any similar type items are allowed anywhere. Minors are not allowed to operate bicycles at any time anywhere on the grounds. No speeding, wheelies, stoppies or racing in the paddock or on access roads will be tolerated before, after or during the event. (Subject to fine and/or eviction)

**No Pets are allowed** except those required to assist handicapped individuals.

**Quiet Time:** Unmuffled engines must not be started or run between 8:00pm and 8:00am each day. Do not play loud music or bass-boomers in camping areas and paddock; be considerate of others.

**Fire Extinguishers:** Each participant must have at least 1 portable Dry Chemical fire extinguisher with a rating of at least 12 BC available and in good working condition in their pit area.

**Protect the asphalt:** Stakes or holes of any kind in any asphalt surfaces are not permitted. Offenders will be held liable for all damages and may also be ejected from the premises. Jacks are permitted but MUST have metal or wood under the jack and jack stands to prevent indentations or holes in the asphalt. Kickstands on asphalt must have something under them to distribute the weight.

Do not fuel your motorcycle or any other vehicle on any paved areas, except only as permitted on pit road during racing competition. Any fuel spills shall be immediately cleaned up and disposed of in proper receptacles.

**Disposal of Waste Fluid and Environmental Debris:** Use of the marked drums is mandatory for used oil, coolant, brake fluid, and other polluting material. Any dumping on grounds or in unauthorized containers will result in a \$200 fine and possible eviction. Participants are to take with them all used tires, batteries and unwanted parts. Environmental debris left behind may result in fines or fees.

**Alcoholic Beverages:** Alcohol of any kind is prohibited in the paddock, pits and buildings during Hot Track hours. Anyone breaking this rule will be removed from the premises immediately and may be fined. You are responsible for anyone in your pit - including participants, crew, guests and visitors.

Keep a Fire Lane open to traffic at all times by parking paddock vehicles and campers inside your pit area. Do not park on or damage grassy areas.

No banners may be hung or attached to any facilities or structures. No flyers or handbills may be distributed.

No smoking is permitted in the restrooms or in any of the buildings. No food or beverages except in designated areas.

No campfires/ground fires; no fireworks, firearms or weapons are permitted.

No standing on pit wall; no climbing over fences. Fence jumpers will be ejected from the property. Do not enter areas behind fences without permission from emergency personnel.

No abusive behavior, vandalism or unlawful activities. Subject to ejection and/or arrest.

**Pick up all race entries and other paperwork from REGISTRATION, located in the CREDENTIALS BUILDING as you enter the track.**
